Abbreviations:

- mr - magic ring
- sc - single crochet
- dc - double crochet
- hdc - half double crochet
- tr - treble stitch
- st - stitch(es)
- R - round(s)
- ch - chain
- sl st - slip stitch
- dec - (invisible) decrease
- inc - increase
- cc - color change
- FO - fasten off
- BLO - back loop only
- FLO - front loop only
- BO (3) - bobble stitch (3)

for the invisible
decrease, insert your
hook through the front
loops only

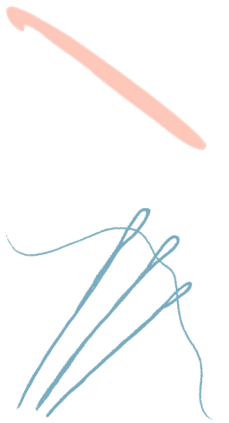
pulled through with (3)
loops on hook



Materials



- Preferred yarn and colors
- Thinner yarn for embroidery (I used black)
- Preferred hook (I used 4mm)
- Stuffing
- Yarn needle
- Stitch marker
- Scissors
- Safety eyes (I used 8mm)



The yarn I used



“Honey Bunny”
pink
plum

“YarnArt Dolce”
white

“Friends Cotton 8/4”
black

Chenille
yarn weight super bulky

for embroidery

SAKURA STINGRAY

starting in pink:

R1: 8sc in mr (8)

R2: 8inc (16)

R3: (sc, inc)x8 (24)

R4: (2sc, inc)x8 (32)

R5: sc around (32)

- now we're making the petals
- everything written in brackets is worked into the same stitch

R6: in FLO: [(sl st, hdc), (dc, tr), (dc, hdc), (sl st)]x8

- at the end of R6 we will make the tail:

ch8, in 2nd ch from hook: sc down the chain, sl st back into the same st (7)

- FO pink & cc to white for the belly

in BLO of R6: (2sc, dec)x8 (24)

R7: (sc, dec)x8 (16)

- place eyes between R5 & R6, approximately 5st apart
- stuff, but not too firmly so the stingray keeps it flatter shape

R8: 8dec (8)

FO, close the hole, hide yarn ends

place a stitch marker into the first BLO to find them easier later



Center Highlights:

Embroider the center of the sakura with darker pink to create the characteristic blossom center. Instead of embroidery you can use powder blush.



Optional: embroider a mouth between the eyes onto the underside of the stingray
