Abbreviations:

- mr - magic ring
- sc - single crochet
- st(s) - stitch(es)
- R - round(s)
- ch - chain
- sl st - slip stitch
- dec - (invisible) decrease
- inc - increase
- cc - color change
- FO - fasten off
- BLO - back loop only
- FLO - front loop only
- (...) x N = repeat N times

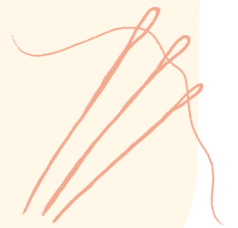
for the invisible
decrease, insert your
hook through the front
loops only



Materials



- Preferred yarn and colors
- Thinner yarn for details
- Preferred hook (I used 4mm)
- Stuffing
- Yarn needle
- Stitch marker
- Scissors
- Safety eyes (I used 12mm)



The yarn I used:



"Honey Bunny"

- White (01)
- Red (40)
- Grey (118)
- Brown (09)
- Yellow (21)

Body
yarn weight
super bulky

"Cotton 4/8"

- White
- Black

Embroidery
yarn weight
super fine

Feet (make 2)

- in brown

R1: 6sc in mr [6]

R2: (sc, inc)x3 [9]

R3: sc around [9]

- stuff only the bottom part of the feet

R4: (sc, dec)x3 [6]

R5-R6: sc around (2 rounds) [6]

R7: fold in half and sc through both layers [3]

FO, hide yarn tail



Lighthouse

- start in white

R1: 8sc in mr [8]

R2: 8inc [16]

R3: (sc, inc)x8 [24]

R4: (2sc, inc)x8 [32]

R5: (3sc, inc)x8 [40]

R6: in BLO 16sc, 3sc through both the leg and the body, 2sc, 3sc through both the leg and body, 16sc [40]

R7-R9: sc around (3 rounds) [40]

- cc to red

R10: (8sc, dec)x4 [36]

R11-R12: sc around (2 rounds) [36]

- cc to white

R13: (7sc, dec)x4 [32]

R14-R15: Sc around (2 rounds) [32]

- cc to red

- place eyes between R9 & R10, aligning with the feet, approximately 5sts apart

- continue on the next page



- start stuffing and continue as you go, making sure to stuff firmly
- as you stuff, be sure to keep rounds 1-5 nice and flat so Lenny will be able to sit nicely

R16: (6sc, dec)x4 [28]

R17-R18: sc around (2 rounds) [28]

- cc to white

R19: (5sc, dec)x4 [24]

R20-21: sc around (2 rounds) [24]

- cc to red
- FO white

R22-R24: sc around (3 rounds) [24]

- cc to grey
- FO red
- for R25 & R29 when you crochet into the FLO, mark the first BLO with a stitch marker to find them easier later

R25: in FLO sc around [24]

- cc to yellow

in BLO of R25: sc around [24]

R26-R28: sc around through both loops (3 rounds) [24]

- cc to grey
- FO yellow

R29: in FLO sc around [24]

in BLO of R29: (4sc, dec)x4 [20]

R30: (3sc, dec)x4 [16]

R31: (2sc, dec)x4 [12]

R32: (sc, dec)x4 [8]

- finish stuffing

R33: 4dec [4]

FO, close the hole and hide yarn tail



add eye details, a mouth and blush if you like
